

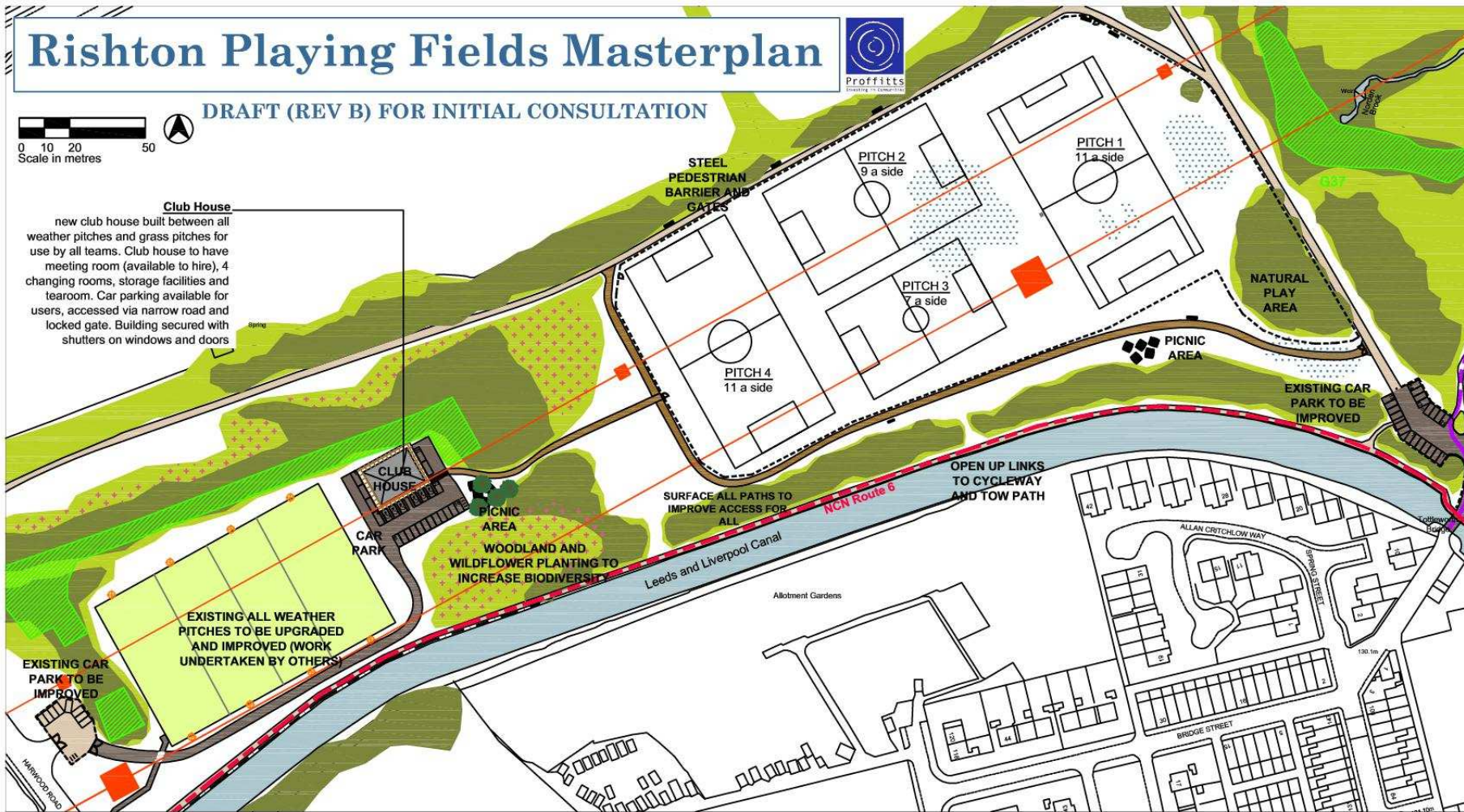
# Rishton Playing Fields Masterplan
