Public Conveniences
convert old WC's into storage facility for park staff (whilst retaining some washing facilities for use by staff)

Trees
Information about existing unusual trees and shrubs around the park. Potential to have tree trail leaflets or posts that form an activity for children and visitors. Any new trees to be chosen with the aim of creating a mini arboretum

Bowling Green
encourage more use of green by arranging sessions for children and young people; tournaments during summer months for local people or between schools. Existing uneven flagged paths to be replaced with new macadam paths to give better access for all

Cafe
potential to replace existing structure or extend existing cafe to incorporate toilet facilities and a larger dining area with facilities to cater for groups and clubs such as bowling and tennis groups

Artefacts
interpretation of old artefacts, signs and pieces of stone - about where they came from and their history

Boundary Trees
Existing boundary trees (mainly lombardy poplars) to be taken down (due to disease) and replaced with smaller species that provide year round interest with blossom, fruits and colourful bark

Formal beds
Some formal beds to be removed and turfed over or planting replaced with low maintenance perennials to reduce maintenance costs so expertise and time can be focussed on other parts of the park. This work is already underway

New Fitness Area
new gym equipment recently installed. Fencing and hedgerow to be removed to make area more welcoming

Picnic Area
additional picnic tables installed to create picnic area and informal kick about/run about area for toddlers

Animal Enclosures
replace old animal enclosures with smaller runs where children can get closer to the animals. Include for new signage and interpretation with information about the animals and their names. Aviary to be retained

Paths
all paths to be relaid with new tarmac surface and new concrete edgings to make maintenance and mowing easier

Play Area
replace old equipment (such as round climbing frame, toddler swings, slide and junior swings) with new equipment to make the play area more challenging. New equipment to include springies and basket swing with colourful rubber surfacing
