## Project Description

The Community Centre is very well used but the layout of the previous garden didn't encourage use and was hard to access by some users because of the gravel surface. The plants and weeds had got very large and hard to maintain by volunteers.

Proffitts worked with the group to design the new garden layout and tender the works. The project consists of new surfacing to the whole garden area with raised beds and planters that are easier to maintain. Decorative railings and gates ensure the site and users are safe. Colour and interest has been created through the large murals and mosaics that surround the whole Centre and Gardens. The Centre and users have been involved in making on site decisions with the contractor as well as designing and creating their own mosaics.

The result is a large open space that can be used throughout the year and that can accommodate all members of the community for a wide range of events and activities.
