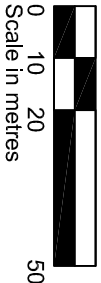


Rishton Playing Fields Masterplan

Fencing
steel paladin pedestrian barrier around existing grass pitches with galvanised steel gates to keep dogs off the pitches and secure the area

Grass Pitches
Existing pitches altered to accommodate 2 new pitches and surface upgraded with new drainage as sections of the pitch are prone to puddling

Club House
new club house built between all weather pitches and grass pitches for use by all teams. Club house to have meeting room (available to hire), 4 changing rooms, storage facilities and tearoom. Car parking available for users, accessed via narrow road and locked gate

All Weather Pitches
existing all weather pitches to be upgraded/repaired to prevent puddling and poor drainage
